

Museum of the People of Valleys of Lanzo

Ceres

The museum, located at the Municipality of Ceres, was officially inaugurated on 23/07/1982. It consists of six sections: Valli di Lanzo, People, Agriculture and Sheep Raring, Craft work, Flora, Fauna and Mineralogy.

For each piece there is a short descriptive caption.

Some items relative to the use of stone are of great interest, as various work tools and items of daily use, which refer to traditional activities operated by the people of the valley, from the agriculture, to the processing of milk products, weaving, metal moulds, especially the nails, exported to all of Italy. They describe with sufficient clarity the conditions of life like it used to be and immediately render the image of a composite mountain civilization. Besides these items, there are also old photographs and reproductions of ancient maps.
